CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE

MISSING CLOSE QUOTE REGULATIONS 2024

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 123 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. This Regulations is the Missing Close Quote Regulations 2024 and comes into operation on 16 October 2024.

Amendment of Fourteenth Schedule

2. In the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) Notification 2024 (G.N. No. S 470/2024), in the Fourteenth Schedule, under the heading "**Subjects**", in item 2(1), replace "Adoption of Children Act 1939" with "Adoption of Children Act 2022".

Amendment of section 43

- 5. In the principal Act, in section 43
 - (a) in subsection (1)(k), delete "or" at the end;
 - (b) in subsection (1)(l), replace the comma at the end with "; or";
 - (c) in subsection (1), after paragraph (l), insert
 - "(*m*) for such other activity as may be prescribed,";
 - (d) after subsection (1), insert
 - "(1A) Where a project is prescribed for the purposes of subsection (1)(m), the regulations may further provide that approval under this section may not be

granted to any company in respect of the project after a prescribed date.";

- (e) in subsection (7), replace "between 1 April 2010 and 31 December 2026 (both dates inclusive)" with "from and including 1 April 2010 up to and including 31 December 2026 or such earlier date as may be prescribed";
- (f) in subsection (8), after "1 January 2029", insert "or such earlier date as may be prescribed";
- (g) in subsection (9), replace "between 20 February 2018 and 31 December 2028 (both dates inclusive)" with "from and including 20 February 2018 up to and including 31 December 2028 or such earlier date as may be prescribed"; and
